Content Connections

Math & Science: In math, students will tell time to the nearest minute and solve problems determining elapsed time. They will also estimate and measure liquid volumes. In science, students will identify natural resources and give examples of methods for conserving.

ELA & Social Studies: The students will identify context clues, write a text dependent analysis, identify plurals that end in y and f, and identify simple/complex sentences. In SS, students will be able to identify the interactions of colonists between the Native Americans and Africans.

In Read 180, students will participate in independent reading, software, and small group. In small group, we will target specific reading/writing skills based on the needs of the group.
