Content Connection:

In Math & Science, In math, we will continue skill and drill our 2-digit by 1-digit multiplication, but also spend time working with real-words problems. We will also begin learning to measure to the nearest $\frac{1}{4}$ inch and sharing our measurements on a line plot. We will extend our knowledge of fossils as we begin a unit on natural resources and fossil fuels in science.

In ELA & Social Studies, in ELA, we will work on persuasive writing, identifying homophones, using context clues, identifying figurative language, answering literal and inferential questions, and writing a summary.

In Read 180 Workshop, the students are learning how to write an explanatory essay. In Independent Reading, they are reading books on their levels and completing graphic organizers. In Software, they are working in each zone.
