Math \& Science: In math, students will identify quadrilaterals and describe attributes of different types of quadrilaterals. In science, students will discuss the scientific method and begin discussing Earth's renewable and nonrenewable resources.

ELA \& Social Studies: Students will identify text structures, write an opinion piece of writing, identify plurals that end in $y$, identify the fact opinion, and identify simple/complex sentences. In SS, students will be able to identify how European settlers contributed to the development of colonial South Carolina.

In Read 180, students will participate in independent reading, software, and small group. In small group, we will target specific reading/writing skills based on the needs of the group.
