

<u>Math & Science</u>: In math, students will determine the area of polygons using different strategies and relate the concept to multiplication. In science, students will analyze characteristics of environments and describe how the environment supports different living things.

<u>ELA & Social Studies</u>: In ELA students will be able to write a text dependent analysis, review over language skills, identify multiple meaning words, and identify narrative elements in chapter book.

In <u>Read 180</u>, students will participate in independent reading, software, and small group. In small group, we will target specific reading/writing skills based on the needs of the group.
