

Math \& Science: In Math students will compare numbers and write them in different numeric forms. In Science, students will recognize and describe different forms of energy.

ELA \& Social Studies: In ELA students will be able to determine the theme of a story by recalling detants that support the theme. They will also create a narrative piece of writing by understanding narrative elements and use quotations correctly. In Social Studies, students will compare the culture, governance, and physical environment of the Cherokee, Catawba, and Yemassee Native Americans.
