## Content Connections

Math & Science: In Math students can represent fractions and compare different fractions using  $>$ ,  $<$ , and  $=$ . In science students can explain how electricity is transferred in a circuit.

ELA & Social Studies: In ELA students will be able to determine the theme of a story by recalling details that support the theme. They will also create a narrative piece of writing by understanding narrative elements and write in a complete sentence with correct punctuation and capitalization. In Social Studies, students will compare the culture, governance, and physical environment of the Cherokee, Catawba, and Yemassee Native Americans.
