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## Content Connections

Math \& Science: In Math students can solve addition problems with and without regrouping. In Science students can classify the states of matter and describe how heating and cooling changes states.

ELA \& Social Studies: In ELA students will be able to ask and answer questions, identify and use commas, and identify an informational piece of writing. In Social Studies students will identify the 6 regions of South Carolina.
